RE: Michigan Emergency Management Assistance Compact (MEMAC)

For the Agenda of January 18, 2010

Background. On February 04, 2004, the City of Clare became a signatory to the MEMAC compact by adoption of Resolution 2004-026 (*copy att'd*). This program, which is under the management of the Michigan State Police, allows individual counties, municipalities, townships, tribal nations, and other inter-local public agencies within the state to call upon and request the resources of other governmental agencies on a reimbursable basis in the event of emergencies or disasters that are beyond the capabilities of local resources to handle – the caveat being that the requesting governmental agency must be a signatory to the MEMAC Compact. The City of Clare enrollment has lapsed, thus the City Commission is asked to allow us to renew our membership.

Issues & Questions Specified. Should the City Commission adopt the required resolution authorizing the City of Clare to continue as a signatory of the Michigan Emergency Management Assistance Compact?

Alternatives.

1. Adopt the resolution.
2. Do not adopt the resolution.
3. Defer or delay decision on this matter for a subsequently scheduled meeting.

Financial Impact. There is no immediate, direct financial commitment attached to the Compact. However, members of the Compact are obliged to provide requested resources to other members on a reimbursable basis and, conversely, reimburse other members for services received if requested.

Recommendations. I recommend that the City Commission adopt Resolution 2010-026 (*copy att'd*), thereby approving the City's membership in MEMAC.


