STATISTICS:

This month we had over 198 events of activity. 180 of them were incidents, 18 were arrests, 7 of the incidents were traffic crashes, and 26 total tickets were issued. There were no parking citations issued. Our highest category was for calls to investigate suspicious situations / persons.

COMPLAINTS:

We had some more car breaking and entering and ended up arresting two local males for the crimes. They will be processed in the Isabella County Court Systems. Our arrests and complaints were slightly down this month compared to last month.

TRAINING:

This month our staff had interview, self defense, and firearms training.

AUXILIARY DIVISION:

Our Auxiliary / Cadets have worked over 200 hours this month. All of these officers will be great additions to the city and our services we provide.

EQUIPMENT:

Our new patrol car arrived and is in use and on general patrol now. .

COMMUNITY RELATIONS / PR ACTIVITIES:

We read books to some of our local kids at the library this month.

Our new Neighborhood Watch Coordinator, Bob Andreotti, continues to do a great job in moving our program forward in a progressive direction. He has hosted a few meetings at the Gateway Village Highrise, Rosewood Manor, and he has met with some of our Church leaders in an effort to seek their input and participation in our Neighborhood Watch Program. He and Lori Schuh are assisting the department in doing a Business Watch Program and a National Night Out Campaign soon. Bob has been a valuable asset to our program's progress and we are very fortunate to have him on our team. We are also preparing for our Youth Police Academy in June.

We are exploring future options with grant opportunities and we will keep you posted should the develop.
