RE: Renewal of Concrete Services Contract



For the Agenda of April 19, 2010

Background. By adoption of its Resolution 2009-040 (*copy att'd*), the City Commission approved concrete and curb bids and awarded the work associated with the City's curb and sidewalk projects to Gallihugh & Sons of Breckenridge, Michigan. During the budget workshop session of April 5th, we mentioned to the City Commission that the contractor has offered to "hold" his bid prices for concrete work (curb and sidewalk) the City intends to schedule for the 2010/2011 budget year. The City Staff informed the Commission that we would recommend that we accept the contractor's proposal; the Commission is asked to consider acceptance of this offer.

For background information, the City received three bids last year, as outlined in the attached Bid Memo of Bob Bonham.

Issues & Questions Specified. Should the City Commission renew the concrete services proposal of Gallihugh & Sons?

Alternatives.

1. Renew the services approval.
2. Direct the solicitation of bids for these services.
3. Set aside decision regarding this matter to a later date.

Financial Impact. Renewal of the services will "hold" the prices we paid during the current budget year for another one-year period.

Recommendation. I recommend that the City Commission renew the concrete services proposal of Gallihugh & Sons by adoption of Resolution 2010-032 (*copy att'd*).

RESOLUTION 2009-040

A RESOLUTION OF THE CLARE CITY COMMISSION APPROVING CURB BIDS.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Clare City Commission hereby approves the curb bids and awards the contract for said work to Gallihugh & Sons of Breckenridge, Michigan contingent upon approval of the appropriation which will allow funding of said work.



We recently advertised for sealed bids for installation of approximately 3,000 Lineal Feet of F4 Modified Curb for 2009-10. Bids were opened at 2:03 p.m. on Wednesday, April 15, 2009. Three bids were received as follows:
