

SUPERINTENDENT'S MONTHLY OPERATING REPORT WATER & WASTEWATER TREATMENT JUNE 2010

Wastewater Treatment Plant

In addition to their routine duties, our Operators performed the following tasks:

- *WET testing continued due to problems with the Daphnia test.
- *John Holland traveled to Kenosha Beef Products in Kenosha, WI with Jason Borchert of GFA to view first hand an installed Webitat module.
- *The Pilot Plant Study continued.
- *Exterior doors were painted.
- *The landscaping was revamped in front of the WWTP.
- *Belts were replaced on the splash aerator.
- *Rags were removed from several of the aerators over the course of the month.
- *Rail guide flanges were replaced at lift station 8 and 2.
- *Several relays failed in lift station 7. We are having an electrician come in and look at the station.

Water Treatment Plant

In addition to their routine duties, our Operators performed the following tasks:

- *Cleaning of Well 8 was completed. Bacterial testing is being performed.
- *The landscaping at the WTP was revamped.
- *The fence at the WTP was repaired.
- *The fence at well 9 was moved and added on to due to the construction of the well last fall.

*Lab Safety training was held.
