

# SUPERINTENDENT'S MONTHLY OPERATING REPORT WATER & WASTEWATER TREATMENT JULY 2010

## **Wastewater Treatment Plant**

In addition to their routine duties, our Operators performed the following tasks:

- \*The clarifier room was fogged for insects.
- \*Doors at the WWTP were continued to be painted.
- \*Low level mercury was sampled.
- \*The DMRQ-30 samples were completed.
- \*The pilot plant study was completed. The plant still remains in operation for DNRE inspection.
- \*Kennedy industries sent a technician to examine lift station #7. Several adjustments were made and the station is now functioning well.
- \*Windemuller sent a technician to examine lift station #2. One of the SCADA modules had malfunctioned and was replaced.

## **Water Treatment Plant**

In addition to their routine duties, our Operators performed the following tasks:

- \*Well 8 cleaning was completed and placed back on line.
- \*The booster station was landscaped.
- \*Stamina stadium was sampled for TTHM and HAA5 in accordance with Stage 1 disinfectant by-product rule.
- \*The plant tap, well 8 and well 9 were sampled for 1,4-dioxane.

## **Landfill**

In addition to their routine duties, our Operators performed the following tasks:

- \*Soil gas testing was begun.

## **Administrative Functions**

During the month, the following administrative tasks were performed:

- \*The exterior water tower painting bids were opened. The three lowest bidders were forwarded to Dixon Engineering for a formal recommendation. Low bid was Fedewa at \$64,000.
- \* John Holland was elected by his peers to the position of Vice-President of Michigan Rural Water.
- \*Multiple meetings with GFA on the direction of the WWTP upgrade were held.
