

CITY OF CLARE PETTIT PARK CAMPSITE RESERVATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

- In order to reserve a campsite at Pettit Park, you must pay for the first night in advance. The City of Clare will accept checks and cash via in person or by mail. *Please make checks payable to the City of Clare.*
- If you stay more than one night, you may “pay as you stay” for each night after the reservation. Additional payments can be made at the kiosk at the park entrance.
- We will make every attempt to honor your campsite preferences; however, reservations are on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- The City of Clare will not take singular reservations; each party must contain a minimum of four campsites and a maximum of eight campsites.
- Campers may reserve campsites on or after January 1st of each year.
- All reservations must be approved and confirmed by the Parks and Recreation Director.
- Please note that Pettit Park has flush toilets, but it does not have a showering facility.
- Clare City Parks are open from 6 a.m. – 11 p.m., May 1 – November 30.

PETTIT PARK RULES

- Pets must be controlled.
- City ordinance requires pet owners to clean up after their animals.
- Speed limit 10 miles per hour
- Place all refuse in dumpsters.
- Must use fire rings and all fires must be attended at all times.
- Horses, ATV's, and snowmobiles not allowed.
