

CITY OF CLARE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR MICHIGAN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDING FOR THE WATER INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The City of Clare will conduct a public hearing on May 2nd at 6:00 p.m. at Clare City Hall, 202 West Fifth Street, Clare, Michigan, for the purpose of affording citizens an opportunity to examine and submit comments on the proposed application for a CDBG grant.

The City of Clare proposes to request \$2,000,000 in CDBG funds to make improvements to the community drinking water system to include replacement of critical (aged and deteriorated) infrastructure at the City Water Treatment Plant and construct an additional Water -Well to meet existing customer water demands. The City proposes to contribute 28% of the requested grant amount to equate \$770,590 to be funded through Water Funds. This project will benefit at least 51% low to moderate income persons. No persons will be displaced as a result of the proposed activities.
