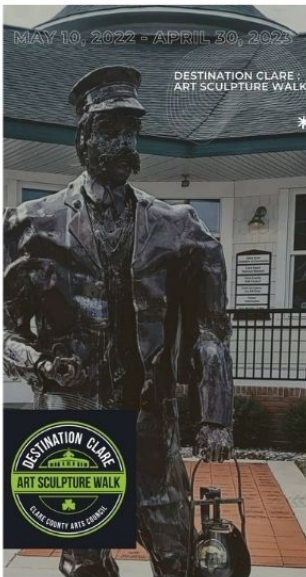

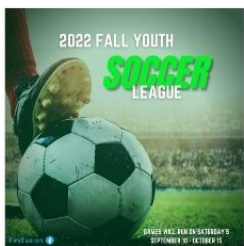
SUMMER HAPPENINGS
